#### **City Council Update**

Due to the outbreak of COVID-19, our last few meetings have been held via teleconference. In these meetings, we voted unanimously to strengthen the City's emergency response, directed the public to follow guidelines issued by public health officials, and funded the Small Business Resilience Grants managed by the Mayor's team.
